

Israeli Campers

- Currently 46 Israeli campers enrolled (4 @ RDC), expect a few more through normal channels (NOAM, staff kids, "randoms")
- CRW recently selected by JUF to host a delegation from Kibbutz Nir Oz (Gaza Envelope), anticipating ~10 campers (up to 14) accompanied by social worker and two counselors through Campers2Gether program

Berlin/Ukrainian Campers (through Berlin Masorti and R. Gesa Ederberg)

- 4 German campers (1 veteran)
- 3 Ukrainian campers the community has taken in (3 veteran)
- Possibly 2 additional Ukrainians (new)

Ukrainian Campers (through Maccabi USA)


