The community we build at Camp Ramah in Wisconsin each summer is infused with our four core pillars: Joy, Growth, Inclusion, and Connection. We keep these values in mind while planning all aspects of the summer and ask all members of the Ramah community to embrace them.

Sign the Camper B'rit (Behavior Contract)

The Camp Ramah in Wisconsin Summer 2025 *B'rit* (Covenant) lays out basic behavioral expectations for the summer which are tied to camp's rich Jewish environment and educational vision. These expectations are based on our four core values, which are deeply grounded in Jewish tradition:

- 1. **Connection** *Kehillah k'doshah*: Camp is a holy community.
- 2. Inclusion B'tzelem Elohim: We are all created in the image of God.
- 3. **Joy** *Bishvili nivra ha'olam*: Each of us is so important that we could say that the entire universe was created for our sake.
- 4. **Growth** *Talmud torah k'neged kulam*: Learning is of paramount importance, of equal value to following all other commandments.

We ask that you read the full *B'rit* in the Forms section of your <u>CampMinder</u> <u>account</u> or in your <u>Campanion app</u>, have a conversation about the content of the *B'rit* with your camper, and then have your camper sign the B'rit, so we may partner together to build our holy Ramah community this summer.

Please complete the bunk request form in your <u>CampMinder account</u> or in your Campanion app. Note: Bunk requests will not be considered until the Camper Care Intake form is complete.


